

LANCASTER, NEW YORK..WEDNESDAY, JULY 9,1969.

Richie Evans of Rome , New York was the winner of the exciting 100 lap All Star League Race at Lancaster Speedway, Lancaster, New York.

This was the third League race of the season, and the third time an open competition driver has taken winners honors.

The first 30 laps were lead by Charlie Jarzombek of Baiting Hollow, N.Y., representing the Islip team. Dutch Hoag of Bath, N.Y. running open competition, charged from 11th position and took over the lead on the 30th lap, with Bill Rafter of Niagara Falls, N.Y., also open competition, on his heels, followed by Jarzombek.

Richie Evans starting in 18th position was closing in rapidly with his orange #61. On the 70th lap, Hoag ran into suspension problems and dropped a drive shaft, placing Bill Rafter in the number one position, followed by Jarzombek, and Evans still closing the gap.

The 90th lap proved to be an exciting one with fans cheering, as Evans passed Jarzombek coming off the fourth turn, and surged past Rafter on the main straightaway, taking over first place and on to win the checkered flag.

Maynard Troyer of Rochester, N.Y., an open competition driver, came from 16th starting position to finish in fourth spot.

No caution flags appeared throughout the entire 100 lap race.

The League race proved to be one of the fastest, with an average speed of 84.90 mph in 35 minutes 20 seconds on the 1/2 mile asphalt track.

Will Cagle of Tampa, Florida representing the Nazareth Speedway, leads in the All Star drivers point standing, with a total of 84 points.

Budd Olsen of Orange County Speedway, and Lou Lazzaro of Catamount are tied for 2nd place with 65 points each. In the League Team Point Standing, Orange County and Catamount are tied for first place with 139 points each. These teams will duel to break the tie at the next two League races.
