GSVSCC Scholarships

The Garden State Vintage Stock Car Club is offering two scholarships annually as follows:

- a one-year grant of \$1,000 if applicant attends a technical school offering certification in 12 to 18 months;
- a \$1,000 grant for one year of a 2- or 4-year college program.

While this scholarship is primarily intended for technical school relating to auto mechanics or college, the award may be given to applicants interested in automotive-related subjects (i.e. writing, public speaking, PR work, graphic arts or PC skills).

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Applicant must be:

- a student with a minimum of a "C" average going to college or technical school;
- referred by a GSVSCC member, friend or relative of a GSVSCC member; or
- referred by high school/vocational school guidance counselor; or
- someone with a connection to local auto racing;

Applicant must choose at least 3 topics from the following list and submit a typed essay (800 to 1,000 words):

- What are your career goals?
- Why did you chose the school you plan to attend?
- What high school activities have you participated in (i.e., student government, sports, clubs, etc.)?
- Have you participated in any non-school related activities (i.e. community, religious, scouting, etc.)?
- Tell us about any summer and/or after-school jobs you have held. What aspects of them did you enjoy? What did you learn from being in a workplace? How would you describe your ideal job?
- What was the most significant course that you have taken in preparation for your chosen career, and in what way did it help you?
- How would you use your education to help preserve the history of auto racing?
- Please include anything else that you would like the committee to know about you that would help them consider you to be a deserving recipient of this scholarship.
